Dial 9 first to get an outside line  
IN AN IMMEDIATE EMERGENCY DIAL  
112/999 AND SPECIFY THE SERVICE  
YOU REQUIRE  
(fire/gardaí/ambulance, etc.)

**In the event of needing to make an Emergency Call follow these steps:**

1. On NUI Galway internal phones, dial 9 for Outside Line.
2. In an immediate emergency dial 112/999\*\* and specify the emergency service required  
(\*Use either number on a land line but only 112 on a mobile phone).
  - » Ambulance (Cardiac)
  - » Fire Brigade
  - » Gardaí
  - » Lifeboat/Mountain+cave rescue/Coastal
  - » Other
3. For medical emergencies in particular give the details set out in the Pre-Hospital Emergency Care Council's "Red Card". Details underlined apply to all emergencies.
  - » Phone number you are calling from
  - » Exact Location of Incident (Give any landmarks)
  - » Chief complaint
  - » Number of patients/people
  - » Age (approximate)
  - » Gender
  - » Conscious? yes/no
  - » Breathing normally? yes/no
  - » If > 35 years Chest pain? yes/no
  - » If trauma Severe bleeding? yes/no
  - » Hang up Last !!!
