The Programme

The International Foundation Business Programme at Shannon College is the perfect pathway to your chosen undergraduate degree in Ireland.

This programme is designed to prepare students for further studies in a wide range of fields. It combines an Introduction to Business, Management & Accounting, English Language studies and a full immersion into life in Ireland. The programme can be used as a pathway for entry onto a range of degree programmes at both Shannon College of Hotel Management and University of Galway.

A foundation programme is a component part of the entry requirements for many international students who wish to pursue their Undergraduate studies in Ireland but do not meet the academic and/or English language requirement to access their degree programme directly. This immersive pathway programme, taught at Shannon College of Hotel Management, will ensure students are fully prepared for their further studies.
